The Splits comfortabel naar toernooi-break !

The Splits comfortable to tournament-break !

Er zijn nu 6 speeldagen achter de rug in de WZAD. Op deze zesde speeldag won The Splits 2 de topper tegen Friends Challenger met duidelijke cijfers. Door de vrije dag van The Clan heeft de leider nu een zeer comfortabel voorsprong opgebouwd en kan dus met een gerust gevoel naar de toernooi-break. Bowling Champions won de subtopper tegen Bowling Buddies en eigent zich opnieuw de vierde plaats toe. Onderaan werd het kelderduel om de laatste plaats gewonnen door Incredible Team, dat hekkensluiter blijft maar Swiffers nu duidelijk op de hielen zit.

6 Matchdays have been finished in the WZAD. On this sixth matchday The Splits 2 won the topmatch against Friends Challenger with clear figures. Due to the free day of The Clan the leader has now gattered a very comfortable lead and can look forward with a good feeling to the tournament-break. Bowling Champions won the sub-topmatch against Bowling Buddies and takes back the fourth place. In the bottom the match for the last place was won by Incredible Team, that stays in the last position but is chasing Swiffers now very intensively.

LAGAAN started the duel with **SPARE ME** rather bad. Jitu Bagadia ceded his place after one game to Hitarth Patel (585 out of 3) and from that moment the team started to run better. Ashish Bhansali (800) tried with the help of Shivani Zaveri to oppose his team against Lagaan and was even succesfull in the second game with a win by one pin. Halfway the match Shehul Zaveri came to replace his wife but could not avoid that Lagaan, under the impulses of a gard working Urvesh Zadafiya (794), could win the match in extremis. Good match of both teams !

Het duel tussen **INCREDIBLE TEAM** en **SWIFFERS** was vooral belangrijk voor de laatste plaats in de league. Met een foutloze overwinning kon Incredible Team die rode lantaarn zelfs doorschuiven naar Swiffers maar zo verliep het niet. Martine Verdy en Jean-Pierre De Leenheir (743) hadden de beste start in huis maar vergaten het geleverde werk af te maken in de tweede wedstrijd helft. Bij Swiffers profiteerden Debby Janssen en Karl Vermeulen (701) ten volle van het concentratieverlies bij de tegenstander en konden zo nog de schade beperken. Incredible Team blijft voorlopig nog laatste maar zit nu duidelijk in het kielzog van Swiffers.

*Very interesting was the encounter between **BOWLING CHAMPIONS** and **BOWLING BUDDIES**, or the battle for the fourth place. In team Bowling Buddies Bipin Saspara (763) tried to surprise the opponent with a new player. Ameer Patel could not do anything wrong but was clearly impressed by the strike power of Dharmesh Dholakia (427 out of 2), who ceded surprisingly after 2 games his place to Karan Bagadia. Hitesh Kakadiya played the full match but he could not avoid that the quality of bowling faded away. At the end Bowling Champions was the stronger team, won the match and takes back the fourth place in the standings.*

En dan was er nog de topper van deze speeldag tussen de nummers één en drie in de stand. Zowel **THE SPLITS 2** als **FRIENDS CHALLENGER** kwamen voor de wedstrijd niet aanrukken met hun allersterkste bezetting en dat leverde een onverwacht wedstrijdverloop. Friends Challenger deed het met Hasmukh Ramani en Sanjay Bodara (736) maar deze beide heren bleken uiteindelijk niet opgewassen tegen het betere spel van Frank Van de Merlen (815) en Jordi Roca (808). The Splits 2 won verdiend en leidt nu erg comfortabel voor The Clan.

*And to close the matchday there was the topgame between the number one and tree in the ranking. Both **THE SPLITS 2** as **FRIENDS CHALLENGER** did not send their most strongest players and that brought us an unexpected progress of the match. Friends Challenger tried to overbluff the opponent with Hasmukh Ramani and Sanjay Bodara (736) but both gentlemen were not capable to stop the better bowling game of Frank Van de Merlen (815) and Jordi Roca (808). The Splits 2 merited the victory and is leads very comfortably before The Clan.*
